

Report to Staff and Parents following Board of Management Meeting 24th October 2024

The only item on the agenda for this meeting was the Lottery for Enrolment. The Lottery was overseen by the Community Garda – Gda Francis Murphy.

Enrolment Applications

The closing date for applications for enrolment into first year in 2025/26 was the 22nd October. The school is oversubscribed for 2025/26. As a result the Board held a lottery to determine places in the presence of Garda Francis Murphy. The outcome of the lottery was as follows:

- There were 281 applications for a place in mainstream first year. The school can only take 160 students.
- There were 113 applications from siblings of students who are already attending the school or who previously attended the school. Each of these students has been offered a place.
- There were 2 application for students who are children of a current member of the staff of St. Brogan's College. Each of these students has been offered a place.
- There were 114 applications from students who are the eldest in the family and attend one of the named feeder schools. Only 45 of these students could be offered a place. Students were offered a place using the lottery system outlined in the Admissions Policy.
- There were 41 applications from students who were not the eldest in the family and who attend a named feeder school. None of these children were offered a place.
- There were 9 other applications. None of these children were offered a place.
- There were 2 late applications. None of these children were offered a place.

There were a number of applications for a place in an ASD Base Class. Unfortunately, we only have two spaces available in these classes so a lottery was held to determine who would be offered places and who would be on the waiting list for a place should one arise. The details are:

- There were 26 applications for a place in an ASD Base Class in first year. There are currently 2 places available in an ASD Base Class.
- There were 7 applications from siblings of students who are already attending the school or who previously attended the school. Two of these students have been offered a place.
- There were 0 applications for students who are children of a current member of the staff of St. Brogan's College.
- There were 8 applications from students who are the eldest in the family and attend one of the named feeder schools. None of these students have been offered a place.
- There were 3 applications from students who were not the eldest in the family and who attend a named feeder school. None of these children were offered a place.
- There were 8 other applications. None of these children were offered a place.

There were a number of applications for a place in the Moderate Class. Unfortunately, we only have four spaces available in this classes so a lottery was held to determine who would be offered places and who would be on the waiting list for a place should one arise. The details are:

- There were 7 applications for a place in the Moderate Class. There are currently 4 places available in the Moderate Class.
- There were 0 applications from siblings of students who are already attending the school or who previously attended the school.
- There were 0 applications for students who are children of a current member of the staff of St. Brogan's College.
- There were 2 applications from students who are the eldest in the family and attend one of the named feeder schools. Both of these students have been offered a place.
- There were 0 applications from students who were not the eldest in the family and who attend a named feeder school.
- There were 5 other applications. Two of these children were offered a place.
