LEAVING CERTIFICATE APPLIED-LCA

This is a Two Year Programme which is divided into 4 sessions

Year 1(5th year)

Session 1: September to the end of January

Session 2: February to the end of May

Year 2 (6th year)

Session 3: September to the end of January

Session 4: February to the end of May



CERTIFICATION

- On successful completion of the course each student will receive a Leaving Certificate Applied Certificate
- You are continually assessed over the 2 years ,your final grade is based on 3 components
- ❖1. Completing 7 tasks
- •2. Completing Key Assignments in class and attending at least 90% of thre time.
- ❖3. Final exams in 5th year and 6th year in June.
- Results from Key assignments are given out to students in February and May each year of LCA which gives students a good idea of how they are doing .
- They will be awarded Pass, Merit or Distinction depending on the credits/marks they have earned over the 2 years.

TASKS

The 7 Tasks are a practical activity such as

- Making something in Construction or Engineering
- Putting on a Film show or Soccer tournament to raise money for charity
- Doing project for social studies on drugs.
- Conducting surveys on the use of beauty products.

To gain credits/marks, you are required to:

- Conduct the task
- 2. Write a report on the task
- 3. Attend **an interview** about the task

This helps to develop initiative and experience in putting reports together.

WORK EXPERIENCE

• Students will be on work experience one day a week.

•You must have 90% attendance at work experience to get credits for that component of the programme.
